A dozen outstanding workshops are planned, with such critical topics as:

"Encounter Between Muslims and the West", led by Yvonne Haddad, professor of the History of Islam and Christian-Muslim Relations at the Center for Muslim-Christian Understanding at George Washington University. Her fields of expertise include twentieth-century Islam, intellectual, social and political history in the Arab world, and Islam in North America and the West. A Syrian Christian (Presbyterian), she is the author and editor of a number of books, including *Muslim Christian Encounters* and *Islam, Gender, and Social Change*. Professor Haddad will also be a keynote speaker at the conference.

"Islamophobia in U.S. Middle East Policy", with Kathleen Christison, former CIA political analyst focusing on the Middle East and the Israeli-Palestine conflict, and author of *Perceptions of Palestine* and *The Wound of Dispossession*.

"Jesus Christ and His Mother Mary: A Muslim Point of View" led by Alaa Badr, an activist in the areas of Islamic Education and outreach programs for inter-faith dialog, an engineer by background, he spends about 50% of his time traveling to different countries. He is also a major proponent of Social Media and Open Source one of the engines for growth for the software industry in emerging economies.

"Three Cups of Tea", God's creative diversity, co-led by Iman Jamal Rahman, a Sufi minister and co-founder of Seattle's Interfaith Community Church, adjunct faculty at Seattle University, radio host and author of *The Fragrance of Faith*; and Rabbi Ted Falcon, internationally known spiritual guide, author of *Getting to the Heart of Interfaith*, teacher and student of Jewish meditation and Kabbalah for over forty years. Imam Jamal will also be one of the conference keynote speakers.
